CONDITIONS:

The Kaplan Centre invites applications for grants to support study in 2016 that involves a significant number of courses focused on the Jewish experience and/or Hebrew Language and Literature. Applicants must be current or prospective students at the University of Cape Town. Grants may only be used toward fees and tuition at UCT.

The application form must be accompanied by a CV, academic transcript, proof of acceptance to the relevant study/research programme at the University of Cape Town, and at least two testimonials from persons familiar with the applicant's work. Testimonials must be sent under confidential cover by the referees directly to the Centre. In addition, new applicants must supply a brief letter of motivation.

Grants may be renewed. Applications for renewal of an award must be accompanied by a recent transcript.
